Homework - A Presentation...

For the first piece of homework in Year 4, I would like you to deliver a 'presentation' to the class (max. **2 minutes** which isn't very long!). You should present on **something that really interests you**. This could be <u>anything</u> at all - the choice is yours! You might choose a hobby, book or your favourite animal. You might want to:

- Make a poster about your topic.
- Bring in objects to show during your presentation.
- Display something on the interactive whiteboard (you'll need a memory stick, or you can email it to me: bstrahan@layston.herts.sch.uk).
- Plan some interaction with the audience (e.g. ask a question)
- Practise presenting at home

If the idea of speaking in front of the class is too daunting, you can still prepare a presentation (but skip the actual 'presenting' in front of people).
