Teaching and learning: The children have had another fabulous week of learning. This week in Forest School, the children have a chance to:

- learn about local fauna (grey squirrels) through games
- Keep warm, by dressing in layers and keeping active
- What we learn by going to Forest School

Science week 10th - 17th March: Next week all the children will be engaging with a range of science activities as part of Science week. The class teachers have planned this carefully using guidance from STEM. Also as part of Science week, the children will have the opportunity to take part in the Dinky or Junior Medic training! They will be learning that basic lifesaving skills can make a huge difference in those first few minutes of an emergency. These sessions will happen in school on Monday 13th and Tuesday 14th March.
