Activities

The main activities include:

- Zip line
- Low ropes
- Archery
- Team-building games
- Orienteering
- Parachute games
- Den building
- Free time
- Night walk (deer spotting)

Cost

- The cost depends on the number of children that go.
- It should be between £160 and £200
- There is an initial £40 deposit to pay and the balance can be paid in flexible instalments up until the trip date.

Forms

- If your child goes on the trip, you will be sent a couple of forms to complete.
- The first is a consent form with space to inform us of anything that would be helpful to know (e.g. travel sickness, sleep issues, any anxieties)
- The second is a medication form. With your permission, we can administer medication on the trip (please ask if you need more than one of these forms).

What if you don't go?

- Children that do not attend the trip come into school as normal.
- They would spend the three days in another class.
- Work will be set for them.
