Dear Parents and Carers,

Learning:

Our learning walk this week has focussed on behaviours for learning. The children were all settled, focussed and enjoying the learning in class. The classrooms all look wonderful. The teaching environments are exciting and engaging and the learning walls are being used and added to by the children.

This is so class teachers can safely see the children to their classroom. We appreciate your understanding. **Parking:**

We have noticed some dangerous parking around the school at pick up and drop off. We understand there is very little space and it is very busy but we would ask that you park further away and walk the last part of the journey if you have to drive. We are mindful of road safety and how easy it is for a young child to slip their parents hand and run into the road. We also need to maintain access for emergency vehicles. Where possible please walk in line with our healthy school ethos.

We would also remind parents to turn off the engines whilst waiting to reduce emissions and the impact on the environment.

Drop off and pick up arrangements:

Thank you for your patience during drop off and pick up. We appreciate that it has been busy. We are signposting on the playground for pick up to help organise the number of people on the playground. We would ask that the parents of older children stand back from the gates by preschool to allow the little ones to be collected by their teacher. Families with buggies please can you be mindful of not blocking passage to the walk way for the other children and to wait by the hedge (Please see sign).
