## Just Talk Week

This week is 'Just Talk' Week 2023. Hertfordshire's Just Talk Campaign Week, which focuses on positive mental health. This year our theme for the week, 'Back to Basics', focuses on providing clear information about Just Talk and its benefits to children and young people, parents/carers, schools and professionals throughout Hertfordshire. Mrs Betley is developing the language of feelings in collective worship to support children in identifying and naming their feelings. This then supports their emotional literacy and regulation.
