To make sure that all items are reunited with their owners please ensure all belongings are named.

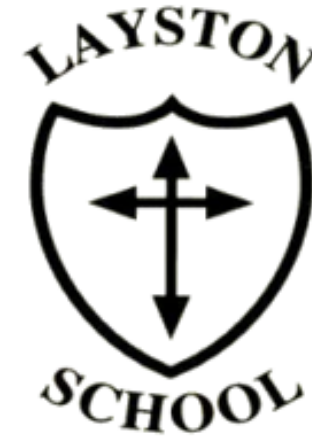
### **Reading**
