
When is it?

Activities

The main activities include:

- Zip line
- Low ropes
- Archery
- Team-building games
- Orienteering
- Parachute games
- Den building
- Free time
- Night walk (deer spotting)



Cost

- The cost depends on the number of children that go.
- It should be around **£210** (for coaches, accommodation, food and activity instructors)
- There is an initial **£30 deposit** to pay, and the balance can be paid in flexible instalments.
- There is a grant available in certain circumstances (speak to the office).
- If you are concerned about the cost, please speak to the office as soon as possible.

Forms

You will be sent two forms to complete:

- The first is a consent form with space to inform us of anything that would be helpful to know (e.g. travel sickness, sleep issues, any anxieties)
- The second is a medication form. With your permission, we can administer medication on the trip (please ask if you need more than one of these forms).

What if you don't go?

- Children that do not attend the trip come into school as normal.
- They would spend the three days in another class.
- Work will be set for them.
