In maths, we have been working on properties of 2D shapes.

1. You could create a picture using 2D shape. This could be realistic, or pattern-based. You could draw it, cut and stick it, paint it, or create it with some kind of technology. Try to challenge yourself! Can you include different types of Hexagons, Octagons and Pentagons, as well as triangles, circles, squares and rectangles?



2. In Geography, we have been looking at Buntingford from the air and on a map, and looking at how to use a compass for directions.

You could:

- a) Draw your own map. You could make up an imaginary land. You could imagine a land from a book you have read. What human and physical features will you include? How will you represent them with symbols?
- b) Get a compass or download a compass app on a phone or tablet. Explore a real map using it, or get outside and have a play. Can you work out what direction things are in? If an adult gets a list of famous places in the world, and tells you whether they are north, south, east or west of you, can you point in the right direction?
