Our curriculum

This term we are learning about dinosaurs, under the sea, mini-beasts and growing.

Our curriculum supports children to develop in all these areas. At the end of the year, we assess children against the Early Learning Goals (ELGs) in these curriculum areas, and we create an Early Years Foundation Stage Profile for your child. This lets you know whether your child is meeting their Early Learning Goals, or continuing to work towards them.

We will explore these topics using our core stories and our provision time.

In PSHE we will be exploring relationships and changing me.

Phonics - Children have been regrouped following the latest RWI assessment. We will continue to consolidate our Set 1 sounds and continue learning Set 2 sounds, along with tricky words linked to our reading books. We will be aiming to read 3-4 times a week. Reading at home with your children really supports this and helps consolidate the skills of blending, with either Fred Talk or Fred in our Head.

In Maths, we will be working on shapes, 2D and 3D, doubling, halving and sharing. We will be counting to 20 and beyond and continuing to practise number bonds to 10.

Characteristics of Effective Learning

Playing and Exploring - children investigate and experience things, and 'have a go'

Active Learning - children concentrate and keep on trying if they encounter difficulties, and enjoy achievements

Creating & Thinking Critically - children have and develop their own ideas, make links between ideas, and develop strategies for doing things

We will be starting to go to Collective Worship on a Friday with the rest of the school and this will increase over the term to every. We will also be working on transitions and preparing the children for Year 1.

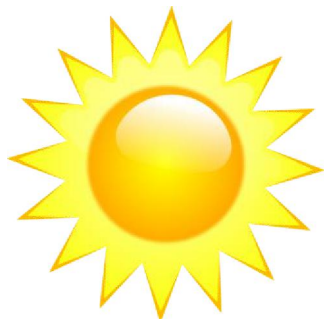
P.E. is on Thursday and Friday. Children need to come to school in their P.E. kit.
