Curriculum

In English, we are continuing to develop the skills the children have learnt in Year 2, whilst looking to progress our writing further through exploring a variety of texts.

In Science, we are studying forces and magnets. This will involve the children doing many practical experiments to develop their knowledge and understanding.

Reading
