We will post on our website and Facebook page, send a communication via Arbor and notify Hertfordshire information services if we are closing the school. This decision will be made in conjunction with the local Headteachers in Buntingford.

If snow is heavy overnight and leads to a closure the next morning, we will ensure that the website and Facebook pages are updated by 8:00am at the latest, however, we will aim for a 7:45am notice.

If a closure decision is made during the day, we will send a communication via Arbor and post on our website and Facebook. We will also publish a time for collection. Please note that the Headteacher and staff will not leave the site until all pupils are accounted for.
