(At least one)	Write a poem about the Autumn or Harvest. 2 points	Write a letter to persuade your parents to go on holiday during half term to a destination of your choosing. 4 points.	Write a story for another one of Arthur's quests. This must be at least 4 paragraphs. 6 points.	Challenge yourself to create <u>an entire graphic novel or at least 10 pages.</u> 8 points.	Write the script for your Christmas play. This must be at least 10 pages long and have at least 3 scenes: a begging, middle and end. It must include characters names, stage directions and be presented as a script, like the play. 10 points.
I enjoy maths. (At least one)	Produce a poster to explain one of the following: - Place values up to 10,000 - Rounding. - Roman Numerals. 2 points.	Create an guide, with questions, on one of the following: - Column method of addition - Subtraction, including exchange. - Checking through estimation or inverse. 4 points	Create your own maths challenge. It must include 25 questions. Make sure you include questions on place value, addition, subtraction, rounding, and Roman numerals. After you create it, make a separate answer sheet. 6 points.	Find out about a famous mathematician and produce a fact file about them and their work. 8 points.	Create your own maths board game on times tables. Create the pieces, board, cards and instructions. Practise playing it with your family ready to share with the class when you bring it in. 10 points.
I enjoy being scientific.	Make a poster about teeth. 2 points	Find out how toothpaste protests your teeth and produce a presentation on it. You can find out about how its history. 4 points.	Research and produce fact file on Charles Darwin. 6 points.	Create your own model to demonstrate the digestive system. You <u>could</u> always record yourself at home like the video we watched. Bring/send in any photos or videos to share. If you <u>can</u> bring your model in, please do so. This <u>could</u> be made out of Lego if you wish. 8 points.	<u>With adult supervision</u> , carry out a science experiment of your choice. Record your plan, results and conclusion. Take photos of your experiment to help you share your work. 10 points.
I enjoy painting, drawing and visualising.	Draw a picture of an Anglo-Saxon. 2 points.	Produce a fact file about a famous artist of your choosing. 4 points.	Produce a drawing of somewhere near your home. This might be a local park, woods, a tourist attraction or even the high-street. 6 points.	Produce an A4 painting of what you imagine the Garden of Eden to have been like. Consider your use of images and colour throughout. 8 points.	Using recycled materials, produce a large piece of art based on our RE topic: "The Fall." 10 points.
I enjoy being active and doing hands-on activities.	With adult support and supervision, make your family at least one drink every day for a week. This could be a hot or cold drink. Challenge: Make a drink you have never made before such as a smoothie or milkshake. 2 points.	Go out for a walk or bike ride with your family, take photos of your adventure and write a diary entry once you return. 4 points.	Build your own Anglo-Saxon village or fort. This could be big or small. Take photos if you are unable to bring it to school. 6 points.	With your parents, make or bake a dish, bake or meal. Take photos of your culinary masterpiece and write the instructions to make your dish/meal/cake. 8 points.	Write 4 diary entries about going to your sports/activity club. Each entry must be at least two paragraphs long. 10 points.
